



## Statement on the 2030 Federal Emissions Reduction Plan

Today, the Hon. Steven Guilbeault, Minister of the Environment and Climate Change tabled his plan to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 40-45% below 2005 levels by 2030, as required under the *Net Zero Emissions Accountability Act*.

““The automotive industry is fully committed to decarbonizing its products. The Minister’s report released today lacks clarity around already announced commitments for ZEV purchase incentives and charging infrastructure, and what is actually necessary new funding to encourage Canadians to make the switch. Despite this lack of clarity, the larger challenge is the increased ambition – under regulation - for 20% ZEV sales by 2026 and “at least 60%” ZEV sales,” said David Adams, President and CEO, Global Automakers of Canada.

“We need some assurance that the consumer is going to join us on this ride, and at this point that is not entirely clear,” added Adams
